In 2003, Line Shack Winery founders and winemakers, Bob and Daphne Balentine, set out to produce affordable, world-class Cabernet Sauvignon from the new San Antonio Valley AVA in Southern Monterey County. The San Antonio Valley is the site of California's second Mission, Mission San Antonio, where some of the first wine grapes ever planted in California originated.

Our vineyards are located in a high mountain valley within the southern portion of the Santa Lucia mountain range, adjacent to the west side of Paso Robles. Warm days followed by cool nights enable our fruit to achieve extended hang time, maximizing their true varietal characteristics.

Braised beef short ribs in a red wine reduction, seasonal veggies and garlic potatoes would complement this fruit-driven red perfectly.
